

HOW MANY GALLONS OF WATER DOES IT TAKE TO SAVE A TREE?



In a recent issue of *WaterSense Currents*, a quarterly newsletter of *WaterSense* – a partnership program sponsored by the EPA and dedicated to protecting our nation’s water supply – 475 households took a pledge to fix a water-wasting leak in their home. If all 475 follow through, each of these households could potentially save more than 11,000 gallons of water per year. Not only will water savings result, but electricity savings too from not having to pump and treat the water wasted by leaks in their households. The carbon dioxide emissions avoided from these energy savings would be nearly 18,000 kilowatt-hours of electricity per year, eliminating 13 metric tons of carbon dioxide emissions. That’s like planting more than 300 trees!
